Communion Elements


- 12 needed for 2020

This year it was held Oct 4-6, and the theme was "Cherishing All of God's Creations." The keynote speaker was Rev. Dr. Alonzo Johnson, the Coordinator for the Presbyterian Committee of the Self-Development of People Program (SDOP) in our national office. Rev. Johnson talked to us about inclusion, intentional diversity, missional engagement, preventing and alleviating poverty, and equity in diversity.

summer Sunday School. She's even tinkled the ivories as a sub for our pianists. Thanks, Leah, for filling the needs wherever they may be!




Help Youth Group with Christimas Stockings
