As Ossama Kamel said at our Parkview prayer vigil on March 26, "That everybody has a right to live is not a radical concept." May we be the Easter people that we are called to be. Ones who bring hope. Ones who bring love. Ones who bring reform. Ones who create change. Ones who take a stand. Ones who show up. Ones who release the power of resurrection in a country where it can sometimes feel like a perpetual Good Friday. Our pastoral resident's column on her recent activities.

As we moved through our Lenten series on the subject of mission, "Out of Our Hearts and Into the World," the theme of solidarity with human suffering kept coming up for me. This is such an integral part of Parkview's self-understanding, from organizing with Tsuru for Solidarity, to attendance at rallies, and commitments to Interfaith dialogue.

When many people think of mission, they think of mission trips or mission agencies, like Loaves and Fishes. But throughout the season of Lent, I learned to think about mission differently. Mission truly is the pull that calls us to action in the world. It is the deeply held values and convictions that we share together as people of God. Mission is our response to God's call to love one another as we have first been loved by God. The love of God is bold, public, self-sacrificial, connectional, unconditional, and merciful. Each time we live into God's love, we are carrying out the mission of God.

In March, we lamented the mass shooting in Atlanta where eight people, including six Asian American women, were murdered. We held an Interfaith Vigil, bringing together a community of solidarity for a time of prayer. Parkview's witness at our vigil was not only an expression of our own values; it was a profession of God's values: that God unconditionally loves all of humanity, especially those who are suffering. This is a messages that deserves to be shared again and again to bring healing and reconciliation in a world wounded by violence and hate.
